



NURSING DEGREE

As part of the exchange programme, we are very pleased to receive foreign students at the Faculty of Medicine of the Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona. In order to welcome students, we would like to give you some important information.

- The stay must be according to our academic calendar (semester or annual)
- It is only possible to take whole subjects.

1. DEADLINES

Students wishing to start in September → from 1st May to 15th June

Students wishing to start in February → from 1st November to 10th December

Steps to do the application:

1.1. Application on-line

It is only available only in website: <http://sia.uab.es/>

1.2. Documents

Students **are required to produce the following documents** in the same period that on-line application is open:

- **Learning Agreement (UAB form or home university form)**
- **Transcript of records (including all that the student has done in his/her degree at home university)**
- **Certificate of Language in Catalan or Spanish (recommended)**

Without these documents and the on-line application it is not possible to accept your study program at UAB neither your assignment to our educational hospitable unit. Invitation to UAB will be done once accepted your study program.

2. LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS:

To follow studies in Nursing at UAB it is recommended:

- B2 in Catalan or Spanish, if the student wants to take Practicums.
- B1 in Catalan or Spanish, for the rest of the subjects.

Our study programme is based on a big practical charge, where our students are in contact with patients who usually speak in Spanish or Catalan.

No subjects are given in English.

3. ASSIGNMENT EDUCATIONAL HOSPITABLE UNIT:

The Physiotherapy students are all assigned to the Educational Hospitable Unit Hospital Vall d'Hebron during his/her stay at UAB. There the student will follow theory and practicals of the subjects registered.

4. IMPORTANT:

- Students must choose the courses according to the period of study abroad.
- Annual courses can be chosen only by the students who stay for a full academic year, not for a semester.
- Students have a period of **four weeks** after joining the UAB to change their Learning Agreement. After this period, they will not be able to do any kind of changes anymore. Changes must be **first requested to the UAB**.
- Students are not allowed to do only theory or practical from a subject; it is only possible to take the whole subject.

- The final registration of elective subjects will be conditioned to the existence of free places at UAB when the student do his/her registration at the Exchange Office.
- Exchange students are not allowed to take the Final Degree Project.
- Exchange students can only choose subjects from between the ones in the specific planning for exchange students.
