

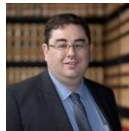


WORKSHOP WITH PROFESSOR ANDRE OBOLER FROM LA TROBE UNIVERSITY (AUSTRALIA)

He is a member of the Australia Government's delegation to the International Holocaust Remembrance Alliance and a former Co-Chair of the Global Forum for Combating Antisemitism. He serves as an executive member of the Jewish Community representative organisations at both state and national level in Australia. He holds a PhD in Computer Science from Lancaster University (UK), and an Juris Doctor from Monash University (Australia).
