- Recognise the basic phonological and lexical system, and understand elementary spoken Chinese expressions related to the immediate environment. (CEFR-FTI A1.1)
- Use the phonological and lexical system and reproduce elementary spoken expressions in Chinese related to the immediate environment. (CEFR-FTI A1.1)
