# 1. INFORMATION ON THE APPLICATION PROCEDURE FOR ACADEMIC STAYS AT THE UNIVERSITAT AUTÒNOMA DE BARCELONA AS PART OF AN EXCHANGE PROGRAMME

The UAB has an on-line application form for this purpose, which will be available at the <a href="http://sia.uab.cat">http://sia.uab.cat</a> web site for the following periods:

- From May 1st to June 15th 2011, for students wishing to start their exchange visit in September 2011.
- From November 1st to December 10th 2011, for students wishing to start their exchange visit in February 2012.

**VERY IMPORTANT:** The application form will only be available for the periods detailed above. After these periods applications will be closed and admission to the UAB as part of the Exchange programme will not be possible.

The on-line application forms filled in by students will be analysed in conjunction with the information sent by their home universities. Please note that any application form sent without prior communication from the student's home university will not be considered.



# • LOCATION OF THE CAMPUS

The main campus of the Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona (UAB) is located 20 km outside of Barcelona, in Bellaterra (municipality of Cerdanyola del Vallès), between the towns of Sabadell and Sant Cugat del Vallès. It is 3 km from Cerdanyola, 4 km from Sabadell and 5 km from Sant Cugat, the most important towns in the surrounding area.

#### BY TRAIN

i. RENFE (Spanish railway network): there are trains from Barcelona (stations: Sants, Plaça Catalunya, Arc de Triomf and Sant Andreu) to Cerdanyola-Universitat. They run every thirty minutes and the journey takes approximately thirty minutes. There is a free-of-charge shuttle bus service which runs from the station to the Campus. 





# 5. REGISTRATION

## REGISTRATION PROCESS

Registration takes place after arrival. For the first semester students usually register in the third week of October; for the second semester students usually register around the second week of March. Before coming to the Exchange Office, you must visit your coordinator in order for him or her to sign your registration form. Notice that you can enrol for any subject offered by our faculty and the rest of the faculties, but you should also be aware that you must enrol at least 50% of your credits in the Facultat of Dret. You should be aware that one UAB credit is equivalent to one ECTS credit.

## CHANGES TO REGISTRATION

For some time after the registration period, you will be able to change the courses that you have registered for. You will need your coordinator to sign the form that can be found at the *Gestió Acadèmica*.

# SERVEI D'ACTIVITATS FISIQUES: SPORTS ON CAMPUS

The sports installations and facilities at the Universitat Autonoma de Barcelona (UAB), administered by the Physical Activity Service (SAF), are the most comprehensive you can find in the surrounding area of El Vallès Occidental, and among the best in the whole of Catalonia. The following sports facilities can all be found on our complex:

2 indoor swimming pools, one shallow and another suitable for all types of training and competitions, including water polo. Annexed to the pools is an open-air space that has been prepared for use as a sport court solarium Gymnasium that is specifically designed for fitness activities incorporating music, dance, etc.

- 1 indoor boulder climbing wall
- 1 climbing wall
- 2 paddle tennis courts
- 5 synthetic surface (green-set) tennis courts
- 5 squash courts
- 1 indoor multisport pavilion divided into three different units
- 1 pelota (and service practice) court
- 1 beach volleyball court
- 1 open air multisport court
- 1 artificial surface football pitch, designed for use for standard football, 7-a-side, football and futsal
- 3 saunas: 1 male only; 1 female only and 1 mixed
- 3 blocks of changing rooms
- 1 hall for lighter gymnastics
- 1 fitness room

In addition to the possibility of using all of the above sports facilities, the SAF offers a whole series of attractive complementary services, such as the Sports Medical Unit. Located within the SAF installations, the Unit's staff are specialised in all types of medical-sport check-ups, and work in full coordination with the UAB's Health Care Service.

Using these installations, we are able to host a wide range of externally organised events, and our team of professionals is also able to assist in developing the organisational stage of a variety of ideas or projects. Led by graduates in Physical Education or by specialised monitors, a large number of physical activities are available to SAF users.

- We offer sessions in the following fitness disciplines: general fitness; aerobic steps; circuit training; combo aerobic; gym-music; tonification; funk and hip-hop; aerobic interval training; physical conditioning and preparation for winter sports. The fitness hall also provides a comprehensive service, offering personalised training plans for keeping fit (beginners' and advanced aerobics) and for specific sports, as well as for entrance tests.
- In the area of lighter gymnastics and expression activities, there are sessions in flexibility, yoga, tai chi and ballroom dancing.
- In water sports, there are sessions in water fitness, water-gym and swimming.
- Finally, in the area of sports, there are sessions in self defence, taekwondo and basketball.

The sports section also provides an attractive range of competitions, both inside and outside the university, as well as dynamic training, in the following areas:

- Team sports: basketball; baseball; flag; football; indoor football; 7-a-side football; korfball; volleyball; beach volleyball and water polo.
- Individual sports: athletics; badminton; kayak; cycling; cross-country; self-defence; chess; climbing; squash; skiing; pelota (and tennis service practice); golf; judo; karate; swimming; orientation courses; paddle tennis; in-line skating; rowing; snowboarding; diving; taekwondo; tennis, table tennis; archery and triathlon.

# Spanish Courses

Students on the LLP-Erasmus programme are entitled to one Spanish course per year for a reduced fee (50%). We recommend beginners or nearbeginners to take an intensive course (in September or February) before starting their university courses. # 8. OFFICIAL PROCEDURES AND LIVING IN CATALONIA

# • FORMALITIES TO ENTER AND LIVE IN SPAIN AS A STUDENT

We can process the documents required by the Government Subdelegation in Barcelona: Targeta Comunitària (work and residence card), Targeta d'Estudiant (student card) and Permís de Treball (work permit) at the International Welcome Point (IWP).

- <u>EUROPEAN UNION (EU) citizens</u> European Union Citizens have complete freedom of movement and residence in Spain.
- 2. OTHER NATIONALITIES Students and Teachers should ask for a "D" Visa at the Spanish Embassy before leaving their country. This Visa is valid for three months. With this Visa you can obtain the Targeta d'estudiant (permission to stay in Spain for one year).

In order to get a Targeta d'estudiant comunitària you must provide your passport (original and copy), registration (application form and proof of payment), two photos, a bank certificate from a bank in Spain showing that you have an annual balance of at least €4.612 (or are the beneficiary of a grant from an official institution). It will not be possible to process the Targeta d'estudiant in Spain if you travel from your country on a tourist visa or without a visa.

#### SOCIAL SECURITY AND STUDENT INSURANCE

If you are an EU citizen and you are covered by Social Security in your country, you will also benefit from Social Security in Spain. You simply have to get an E-128 / E-111 form before leaving your country. There are also bilateral agreements between Spain and Andorra, Brazil, Chile, Ecuador, Equatorial Guinea, Haiti, Iraq, Jordan, Morocco, Panama, Paraguay, Peru, Philippines, Puerto Rico, Syria, Switzerland and the United States, under the same conditions.

Remember that you must be under 28 and have paid the appropriate registration fees at your home university in order to enjoy the right to this insurance cover. If you are a citizen of any other country, you should arrange student insurance in your home country or pay for private insurance on arrival in Spain.

#### COST OF LIVING

According to the students who were here during the 2003/2004 academic year, the cost of living amounted to €750 - 800 per month The cost of living at the UAB depends to a large extent on the price of the accommodation selected. Living in Barcelona is considerably more expensive than living in the nearby towns. The UAB has several student restaurants which provide students with reasonable prices and set menus that cost between €5 and €8. Students can enjoy reductions on train fares. Moreover the different UAB services can be used at moderate prices.

#### TRAIN FARES

In Catalonia there are two railway companies: the Spanish Renfe and the Catalan FGC, which have different prices:

Single tickets can only be used for one specific transport operator but multiple tickets can be used for all operators under the integrated system. There are several types of travel tickets that can be used for more than one mode of transport, and in the different zones as established.

# BANKS

You will find branches of two Catalan saving banks on Campus. "La Caixa" (Caixa d'Estalvis i Pensions de Barcelona) is located at the Rectorat (Building A), and La Caixa de Catalunya, in the Plaça Cívica. There are also ATMs in the different faculties. If you want to open a bank account, you sometimes have to pay a commission and provide your identity card or passport regardless of your nationality.
