

Students interested in taking modules from some Master, should first check with their home university, if this possibility is established on the bilateral agreement signed between both institutions.

Nevertheless, attending master courses is not automatic and it needs the approval of the master coordinator, who has to see the student's CV and academic record. In any case, if demand is higher than offer, we have to make a selection between all the students who are interested on taking master courses.

Students should also know (just in case it was useful) that, after the implementation of the European Space of Higher Education (ESHE), Spanish universities are following the 4+1 system (4 years of undergraduate studies bachelor + 1 year master program). Hence, courses from our fourth undergraduate program are equivalent to the 1st year of a European master.

The level of **English** or **Spanish** required is **B2** according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR).

<u>A maximum of two modules</u> can be taken and once students are officially registered, no changes will be possible and full attendance will be required. On the contrary, the courses will be considerate failed.

Students should follow this process to apply:

- 1. Choose the master they are interested in. Find bellow the links of all our Masters offered to exchange students.
- 2. Choose the modules they are interested in.
- 3. Send to this e-mail Intercanvis.fee@uab.cat the following information:
 - Master name
 - Module code
 - Module title
 - Semester which belongs the module
 - CV together with the <u>academic records of the Master</u> that students are currently studying at their home university, signed and stamped by their university.
- 4. Wait to our confirmation of access

The deadline to send all the required documents is as soon as you have taken the decision in agreement with your home university, but not later than two weeks before the classes start, according to our academic calendar.
