



Types of courses

UAB Idiomes Campus offers three course types: **classroom based**, **semi-classroom based** and **online courses**.

Classroom-based courses place the emphasis on classroom activity and makes up a good number of the total hours – almost half the learning hours. Classroom hours cover the basic objectives of the course syllabus. Students work under supervision or on their own for the rest of the time using the resources provided by the teacher or the UAB Idiomes Campus Self Learning Centre (CAL) online resources. Most courses are classroom based.

Semi-classroom based courses combine classroom attendance with supervised and individual work by students. The number of classroom hours is less than for classroom-based courses. In most cases this type of course is taken using specifically designed materials for distance learning. Students can also use other materials provided by the teacher or the Self Learning Centre (CAL) resources

Online courses are taken using virtual platforms for language learning. Students are usually given a licence to use them for a specific period of time. Any classroom activity is very occasional and of an introductory, monitoring or concluding nature. UAB Idiomes Campus Works with platform that also have a user support service for technical questions. The UAB Idiomes "Languages à la carte" option offers students the chance to learn a wide range of languages on line individually.
