- <u>In these pre-registration forms</u>, the courses are listed indicating the bachelor, year of studies ("curso"), semester and the number of ECTS credits.
- Incoming students can enrol courses from different syllabuses, years and groups of registration.
- The number of credits you must register depends on the requirements of your home university. You have to enrol at least one course at the Faculty of Communication Sciences.
- It is <u>compulsory</u> you choose some extra courses in case some of your choices are not approved, if some of them have overlapping time schedules or if there are groups closed.
- Subjects that needs previous knowledge on the matter/ Spanish-Catalan:

<u>Courses marked with "▶":</u> To enrol on this course/these courses Exchange Students must have an advanced knowledge of Spanish language (Level B2).

<u>Courses marked with "●":</u> To enrol on this course/these courses Exchange Students must be able to prove, by an Academic Certificate, have previous knowledge of the subject. The student must hand in his/her transcript of records from the home university to the Exchange tutor. This authorisation should be obtained on the day of the tutorial.

<u>Courses marked with "■"</u>: It is required a good understanding of English (readings, viewing).

- The incoming students cannot enrol official master's modules of the UAB.
- It is not possible for students to hand in their final BA-/MA- thesis at the host institution. Final thesis need to be graded by the home university.
- UAB is a bilingual University. The official languages are Spanish and Catalan so, some subjects are taught in Catalan and some in Spanish, depending on the teacher. To know the language of the subject, the student can consult the study guides of the courses.
- Incoming Exchange students should have a Level B2 of Spanish language. The type of lessons (related with languages, expression in media and the creation of contents) makes necessarily for all our students to be competent in the language of work of the subject. Exchange students are not required to submit proof of their Spanish proficiency but partner institutions are expected to select students who meet these requirements.
- Courses with less than 15 students will be cancelled. In this case, the student will be able to enrol another course.




IMPORTANT:

SUBJECTS OFFERED BY OTHER FACULTIES

According to the Exchange policy of the UAB, you must enrol at least the 50% of your credits at our centre. The other 50% can be taken at the rest of the UAB faculties, **provided the groups are still open**.

Students who wish to take subjects at other faculties should check the webs of other faculties to find out the timetables, codes and groups for the subjects, if previous knowledge on the subject is required, etc.

These courses must be also indicated in the pre-enrolment forms of the Faculty of Communication Sciences because, although the teaching is given in another centre, the enrolment will be done in the Faculty of Communication Sciences.

ENROLMENT

• 12th September 2022 – Beginning classes:

Although the enrolment of the courses have been programmed some days later, **it is compulsory to attend the courses from <u>the first day of classes</u>. Otherwise, some professors may refuse the admission of the student in the course.**

From 12nd to 19th September 2022:

During this period, the students must:

- 1. Attend classes of all the courses they are interested. This allows them to check the programme and the language of teaching of the courses. If the student needs to change his/her selection of courses, he/she must contact to the home university in this period.
- 2. **OBLIGATORY Tutorial Session**: All exchange students should meet the UAB exchange tutor during this period. Students <u>must send an e-mail to their tutor</u> to make an appointment.

On the day of the tutorial, students should hand in:

- Pre-enrolment documents containing personal details and the list of subjects to be taken.
- Academic transcript from their home university.

It is very important that the day of the tutorial, the student had decided the definitive list of courses he/she wants to enrol, **because later NO changes will be allowed**.

The contact details of the tutors are indicated at the end of this informative dossier.

• 19th September 2022:

The student must send by email the following documents at the Exchange Office (Gestión Académica) of the Faculty (intercanvis.comunicacio@uab.cat):

- 1. Pre-registration form ("Documentos de pre-matrícula") with your personal data, the selection of the courses you want to attend and the signature of your exchange tutor.
- 2. Passport / ID (original and copy)
- 3. Proof of your medical insurance for the whole of your stay in Spain.
- 4. If necessary, the authorization to enrol courses that require previous knowledge signed by your exchange tutor (the document is included in the pre-registration form).
- 5. If necessary, proof you have done the on-line application form of the faculties that required it.

• 21st to 23th September 2022:

The Exchanges Office will do your enrolment and send it to you by e-mail

MEDICAL INSURANCE AND SOCIAL SECURITY

Medical insurance for EU students

If you are a citizen of the European Union or a citizen of Norway, Iceland, Liechtenstein or Switzerland, and you are entitled to social security in your country, you should apply for the European Health Insurance Card (EHIC). This card makes visiting a state-run hospital, doctor's surgery or dental practice in European countries easier and means you will be treated in the same way as someone who lives in that country.

You can obtain a card free of charge by contacting your local health insurance institution as each individual country is responsible for producing or distributing the card in its own territory.

Take into account that the card does not cover private health care or repatriation costs. Visit the EHIC website to find out more: http://ehic.europa.eu/

Once you arrive in Barcelona, to obtain medical care you should go to your nearest public healthcare centre (Centre d'Assistència Primària, CAP) and show your EHIC together with your identity document (ID card or passport).

Medical insurance for Non-EU students

If you are from outside of the European Economic Area you should check whether there is an agreement for healthcare between the Social Security of your country and the Social Security of Spain. If there is such

an agreement, you should submit the necessary documents in your country so that you can have free access to Spanish public healthcare.

In the case of renewing your Residence Card (NIE, TIE) you have to check if the above mentioned document replaces the obligation to present a private medical insurance regarding illness and accidents (Social Security does not include the repatriation to your home country).

If your country has no healthcare agreement with the Spanish Social Security system, you should take out **private insurance cover** for the whole time of your stay in Spain.

LEGAL PROCEDURES FOR FOREIGN CITIZENS

Given the complexity of the documentation to be submitted, we recommend that you consult the International Support Service (before International Welcome Point) about this procedure in advance. This office will provide information about visas and other immigration procedures.

<u>EU-citizen students</u> planning to stay in Spain longer than three months should apply for registration at the nearest National Police Station as a foreign resident. Please, remember that in order to carry out this procedure is recommended to have your European Health card.

If you are a **non-EU citizens holding an EU residence permit**, you can apply to do part of your course in Spain without having to obtain a visa. Applications should be made to the Barcelona Foreigners Office (Calle Murcia, 42) within one month of entry and with a valid residence card from the previous EU country. This procedure could only be applied if your passport were stamped with your entry date at the National Police Station in the airport, or if you process an entry declaration within 3 workings days from your entrance. This declaration can be processed in the following address:

Barcelona

All non EU -citizen students should apply for a "type D" Student visa at the Spanish Embassy or Consulate of their place of residence (normally their home country). For stays less than six months, the received visa would be valid just for 180 days (type D). For stays longer than six months, mind to ask for a "type D" visa for more than 6 months (open), to legalizing your stay permit already in Spain by applying for a Foreign Resident Card, valid up to a year and renewable.

CATALAN AND SPANISH LANGUAGE COURSES

The "Servei de Llengües" (Bellaterra Campus) offer Catalan and Spanish courses, in both intensive and non-intensive formats, which are available before the academic year begins and also during term time. The basic and elementary level Catalan courses are fully subsidised for members of the UAB community, and Spanish courses are partially subsidised for UAB Erasmus students.
