11 - 12h Biogeography and patterns of composition and distribution of Leopard pattern (Leopard Bush) in the north of South-America. Mr. José Eduardo Fuentes

The objective of this PhD is to study and determine the biogeographycal aspects related with present distribution and composition. To achieve this, environmental conditions of la Guajira, which determine its existence, are isolated and based on the thesis that the distribution and composition of Leopard pattern on the Guajira Peninsula is caused by the interaction between anthropic aspects in association with environmental issues such as wind, water and geomorphology, being this interaction responsible for the accumulation of nutrients in the soil which occurs in certain parts of the landscape where vegetation develops.
