Prerequisites

At the beginning of the course students should have a general B1 level in Spanish in each of the four language dimensions. It is offered both semesters.

Learning objectives

This course is taught in Spanish and essentially designed for exchange students or non-Spanish nationals. It comprises an introduction to Catalan society: culture, literature, history, geography and major institutions.

The aim of this course is to provide students with a background to Catalan society, raise their awareness of cultural differences and also serves as a foundation for those considering translating or interpreting from Catalan.

At the end of the course students should be able to:

- Demonstrate their knowledge concerning various aspects of Catalan society today.
- Be able to explain cultural aspects of Catalonia.
- Apply this knowledge to interpret cultural references in the context of cross cultural mediator.

Competencies

Assessment criteria

- Written assignment (40%)
- In-class exercises and activities (20%)
- Final exam (40%)
