#### **Prerequisites**

This course is designed for students from other countries, typically exchange students, whose first language is not Spanish.

There are no specific prerequisites, however all students are required to take a level test prior to starting classes (days/times are posted on the notice board outside Gestió Acadèmica). Different entry level groups are organised (e.g. Beginner A1, Intermediate B1 CEFR etc.) and students will be assigned to these groups accordingly.

\*Note for exchange students on a one-semester stay. This course is offered in single-semester modules during the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> semesters (4.5 ECTS).

# Learning objectives

This course is designed ostensibly for Spanish nationals or exchange students who do not have Spanish as their first language. Learning outcomes as per the CEFR scale will vary according to the group level – see instructor for specific details on language level competencies in each of the four dimensions.
