• Best Paper Award ICDAR 2011:

At the International Conference on Document Analysis and Recognition (ICDAR 2011), Dr Marçal Rusiñol was awarded a prize for the best "Paper" presented in the conference, thanks to the paper entitled *Browsing Heterogeneous Document Collections by a Segmentation-free Word Spotting Method*; presented jointly with doctors David Aldavert, Ricardo Toledo and Josep Lladós.

Prize to the Best Thesis 2009-2010 IbPRIA 2011

Dr Alícia Fornés received the AERFAI Prize for the best thesis 2009-2010 at the Iberian Conference on Pattern Recognition and Image Analysis (IbPRIA 2011) in Las Palmas de Gran Canaria. The conference took place on 8-10 June 2011, and the award went to her thesis entitled "Writer Identification by a Combination of Graphical Features in the Framework of Old Handwritten Music Scores".
