- **Bibliography** (Provide a list of the main bibliographical references on the subject of study. The list does not have to be exhaustive, but it should provide the most complete starting point possible on the research carried out so far and ideally should include recent references)

- **Resources** (Indicate the material resources available to carry out this research project. Indicate whether you have a scholarship or your own financial resources. Also indicate the type of doctorate that you will pursue -full-time or part-time)

- **Time planning** (Timetable -4 years if full-time, 7 years part-time-. Temporarily indicate the sequencing of activities to be carried out during the research)
