Learning objectives

The aim of this course is to consolidate the development of the students' basic communicative competencies in C Language (Russian) to prepare them for direct translation. All course credits are for language skills.

At the end of the course students should be able to:

- Understand short and simple written texts about topics related to the immediate environment. (CEFR-FTI A1.2)
- Write very short and simple texts on topics related to the immediate environment. (CEFR-FTI A1.2)
- Understand short and simple utterances in Russian on topics related to the immediate environment. (CEFR-FTI A1.2)
- Use the phonological and lexical system and reproduce elementary spoken expressions in Russian related to the immediate environment. (CEFR-FTI A1.1)

Competencies

Assessment criteria

The subject will be assessed as followed:

- Reading comprehension: 40%
- Writing exercises: 25%
- Applied grammar skills tests: 25%
- Coursework: 10%

Students must complete a minimum of 75% of all assessed tasks to be given a grade.

These categories may vary from year to year. Definitive weightings will be specified by the instructor at the beginning of the course.
