# Bienestar animal: introducción

- El concepto de “bienestar animal” incluye la salud, el comportamiento y el estado emocional de los animales.
- El bienestar de los animales puede y debe evaluarse de forma científica, utilizando indicadores objetivos.
- Cada especie tiene sus propias necesidades biológicas. Por lo tanto, no puede evaluarse el bienestar de los animales utilizando el antropomorfismo.

# Bienestar animal: introducción

- El bienestar de los animales es importante por razones morales y porque existe una estrecha relación entre el bienestar de los animales y el bienestar de las personas.
- Organizaciones internacionales como la OMSA (Organización Mundial de Sanidad) y la FAO (Organización de las Naciones Unidas para la Alimentación y la Agricultura) promueven el bienestar animal.

### Associations between animal welfare indicators and *Campylobacter* spp. in broiler chickens under commercial settings: A case study

#### ABSTRACT

Few studies have previously investigated how poor animal welfare might be associated with infection of zoonotic pathogens in humans. This paper assesses the predictive value of the presence of *Campylobacter* spp. in broiler chicken flocks when animal-based measures related to footpad dermatitis, hock burns, body lesions and arthritis are identified under commercial conditions (high density). The study population included 32 flocks analysed on farm and at slaughter, slaughtered between April and August 2008 in six different slaughter plants in Brittany, France. Welfare and health indicators are those indicated by the European legislation and sampling was carried out in the framework of the European baseline survey on the prevalence of *Campylobacter* in broiler chicken. Caecal contents, sampled both on farm and at slaughter, and carcass skin samples from the neck and breast at slaughter, were investigated for the presence of *Campylobacter* spp. Logistic models/classification trees were used to estimate the probability of the presence (or absence) of a specific foodborne pathogen in a flock based on specific animal-based measures (or combinations of measures) in order to study the potential relationship be-

#### FVE adopts Day-1 Competences for Animal Welfare

In the June 2013, the General Assembly of FVE delegates adopted a report on how to address animal welfare in the veterinary curriculum

In 2012, FVE established an ad hoc Working Group (WG) to map animal welfare teaching in undergraduate veterinary education and to develop a core curriculum. The WG comprised representatives of FVE, the European Association of Establishments for Veterinary Education (EAEVE) and the EU FP7 research project AWARE (Animal Welfare Research in an Enlarged Europe). In June 2013, the WG finished their task and the report was adopted by both FVE as EAEVE.

# Bienestar animal: docencia

## RECOMMENDATIONS

1. The FVE and EAEVE should actively encourage all European schools to implement these Day One Competences and the corresponding learning objectives, and to have them incorporated and evaluated through the EAEVE/FVE accreditation system of veterinary schools.
2. European veterinary schools should ensure adequate time, staff and practical sessions for teaching animal welfare science, ethics and law.
3. Animal welfare science, ethics and law teaching should be delivered in such a way that the study subject is clearly identifiable in its own right, while being integrated throughout the veterinary course.
4. Animal Welfare science, ethics and law should be a core subject, and examinable with the same pass/fail criteria as other core subjects.
