

WEIGHTING AND CALIBRATION OF THE CRITERIA FOR AWARDING THE JOB POSITION

Pursuant to Article 60 of the Academic Staff Regulations, the committee publishes a breakdown of the criteria for awarding the job position, which are to total 100 points, based on the scoring system established by the department and on the profiles set out in the call for applications.

a) Research and transfer activities (40 points)

Criteria:

Publications: maximum 30 points
for each publication in Q1: 3 point for each publication in Q2: 1 point for each publication in Q3: 0,5 points
Congresses/Conferences: maximum 10 points
for each international congress/conference (oral presentation): 1 point for each national congress/conference (oral presentation): 0.5 points for each international congress (poster presentation): 0.5 points for each national congress/conference (poster presentation): 0.3 points
Research projects: maximum 20 points
for each research project (collaborative researcher): 3 points for each research project (main researcher): 5 points

b) Teaching activities (25 points)

Criteria:

Only teaching in the subject of Medical Histology in the degrees of medicine, nursing, physiotherapy and biomedical sciences will be valued
For every 10 hours of degree teaching: 1.5 points. Maximum 20 points
For every 10 hours of postgraduate teaching: 0.5 points. Maximum 3 points
For each coordination of a subject: 0.5 points. Maximum 6 points
For each teaching innovation project: 1 point. Maximum 6 points
Other related merits: 3 points

c) Training received (15 points)

Criteria:

Doctoral thesis related to health sciences: 5 points
Doctoral award: 5 points
Be hired by a university (that includes a teaching position): 3 points
Pre-doctoral grants, bursaries and other financial support: 2 points
Post-doctoral grants, bursaries and other financial support: 2 points
Bachelor degree award: 2 points

d) Mobility activities (20 points)

Criteria:

For each pre-doctoral stay (> 2 months) in a research centre or university different from the UAB: 5 points. Maximum 15 points
For each post-doctoral stay (> 2 months) in a centre or university different from the UAB: 5 points. Maximum 15 points
Bachelor degree studied in more than one university: 2 points
Post-graduate and doctoral studies received at more than one university: 2 points
Academic non-affiliation to the UAB *: 6 points <i>* It must be taken into account that academic non-affiliation to the UAB must be a preferential merit (no other merit may be assigned a higher score).</i>

Candidates must obtain a total score of at least 70 points from at least two committee members in the four activity types specified above. Those who do not achieve this are excluded. Candidates must also obtain at least 60% of the maximum score assigned to mobility activities from at least two committee members.
