The committee will evaluate the candidates according to the following criteria:

First Phase (100 points)	Second Phase (30 points)	Total (130 points)
Evaluation of CV, considering Research merits and Teaching merits (100 points). To access the second phase candidates must have at least 60 points	Interview based on personal presentation of merits and a short seminar in Human Anatomy and Embryology.	Candidates will be ranked based on the total points of the first and second phase. The candidate with more points will be proposed for contract.

## **SECOND PHASE**

To access to the second phase, candidates must have average score greater than 60. The second phase will consist in a public open telematic interview with the Committee held at the UAB, with the presence of the secretary and candidates. The list of candidates who passed to the second phase will be published three weeks before the start of the second phase.
