Students interested in doing an Internship period should pay a **complementary insurance** ([check the price for each course](#)) at the time of registration (once the students arrive at the Faculty). The complementary insurance is a service offered by the University that consists of accident and civil responsibility insurance for university students resident in Spain.

It is required the **Certificate of Good Conduct** that enables individuals to work with minors in Spain:

Anyone working with children and young people in Spain is required to have a certificate from the Spanish authorities which states that they have never been convicted of a sex-related crime (with adults or children). Foreign students are also required to have a similar certificate from their country of origin. It must be issued in English and must not be older than 3 months at the time of the beginning of the erasmus stay.
