Planned Schedule and Guidelines for the Examination

Candidates who do not appear at the scheduled time will be granted a second call 15 minutes later. If they still fail to appear, they will be considered absent and therefore excluded from the selection process.

The selection process will be divided into two parts and will last a **maximum of 100 minutes** overall:

- **up to 70 minutes will be allocated for the candidate's presentation;**
- **up to 30 minutes will be reserved for questions from the Selection Committee.**

During the presentation, the candidate is expected to:

1. Present and discuss their curriculum vitae, highlighting their academic background, teaching experience, and research activities.
2. Deliver a seminar.

The Selection Committee has established that the seminar must take the form of a lecture appropriate for undergraduate or master's level students and should be related to the profile and subject area of the position.
