

**TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE COMPETITIONS FOR THE RECRUITMENT OF
ASSISTANT LECTURERS (*LECTORS*) IN THE SERRA HÜNTER PROGRAMME (Call no.
2025/D/LEM/CL/9)**

1. General rules

1.1. In accordance with Organic Law 2/2023, of 22 March, on the University System; Law 1/2003, of 19 February, on Universities (hereinafter LUC); the seventeenth additional provision of Law 5/2012, of 20 March, on fiscal, financial and administrative measures and the creation of the tax on stays in tourist establishments; Law 3/2016, of 15 December, which extends, with effect from 1 January 2016, the Serra Hünter Plan, and which was amended by Article 233 of Law 5/2017, of 28 March, and by Article 95 of Law 2/2021, of 29 December, on fiscal, financial, administrative and public sector measures, which extends the Plan until 31 December 2023; Organic Law 2/2023, of 22 March, on the University System (LOSU); the Agreement of the Government of Catalonia, of 16 May 2017, approving the Serra Hünter Plan for the period 2016-2020, specifying its characteristics, which are extended; the Agreement between the administration of the Government of Catalonia, through the Department of Research and Universities, and the Catalan public universities for the development of the Jaume Serra Hünter Plan for contracted teaching staff for the years 2022 and 2023, of 1 January 2022; the Agreement of the Board of the Interuniversity Council of 27 May 2022, on the recruitment of teaching and research staff at Catalan public universities during the year 2022, which modifies the Agreement of the Board of the CIC of 14 October 2022; and the public offer of the Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona for the year 2022, approved by the Governing Council on 28 April 2022 and published in the Official Gazette of the Government of Catalonia on 17 May 2022 and the Academic Staff Regulations of the Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona, approved by agreement of the Governing Council on 17 November 2010 and amended on several occasions, the last one on May 5, 2025 (hereinafter RPA).

1.2. The contracts included in this call do not affect compliance with the budgetary stability objectives of the universities and other limits set out in Organic Law 2/2012, of 27 April, on budgetary stability and financial sustainability and which comply with the provisions of Article 20 of Law 31/2022, of 23 December, on the General State Budget for 2023. In addition, the contracts comply with the provisions of the ninth additional provision of Law 2/2023, of 16 March, on the 2023 budget of the Government of Catalonia.

1.3. These competitions will be governed by current regulations (Organic Law 2/2023, of 22 March, on the University System; Organic Law 6/2001, of 21 December, on universities, modified by Organic Law 4/2007 of 12 April, by Law 1/2003, of 19 February, on Universities of Catalonia, by the Statutes of the Autonomous University of Barcelona approved by Decree 237/2003, of 8 October, of the Government of Catalonia, in the measure that they are applicable).

1.4. The contracts will be on an employment basis and for a maximum duration of six years and will involve carrying out teaching tasks up to a maximum of 180 teaching hours per academic year. The contract is full-time.

1.5 . For all purposes of this call, the month of August will be considered a non-working month.

1.6. The list of available places is as shown in the annex to these terms and conditions.

2. Requirements

To be admitted to the competition, applicants must meet at the deadline for applications and must continue to meet on the date of signing the contract the following requirements:

2.1. General requirements:

- a. Not be suffering from any illness or be affected by any physical and/or mental limitation that is incompatible with the performance of teaching functions.
- b. Not be excluded by a disciplinary procedure from the service of any of the public administrations, nor be disqualified by a final resolution for the performance of public functions.
- c. Not incur any reason for incompatibility, in accordance with the provisions of Law 53/1984, of 26 December, on incompatibilities of personnel in the service of the Public Administrations.

2.2. Specific requirements:

- a. Be in possession of a PhD.

In the event that the degree has not been issued by a Spanish university or recognised in Spain, before the contract can be signed the degree will have to be officially validated as comparable with that of an official nature in Spain ([Equivalence of foreign PhD degree](#)), or have the Accreditation of University Teaching Bodies of ANECA.

- b. Not have reached the maximum period in the category of assistant lecturer in other public universities.
- c. For places in the linguistic and literary fields and in the teaching of language and literature, the C2 level or equivalent certificate of the corresponding language must be accredited at the time of submitting the application to participate in the selection process.

The means are:

- the C2 level certificate or equivalent certificate.
- in the case of English, a certificate of aptitude to teach with the C2 level obtained from the UAB Language Service when it comes to teaching staff who come from a country where English is an official language.
- accreditation that the language of instruction of the curriculum of the degree, or equivalent, that has been taken coincides with the profile of the linguistic field in which they are competing.

2.3. Applicants must have a level of Catalan that ensures the competence of teaching staff to participate adequately and correctly in the communicative situations required by the academic tasks, in such a way that the linguistic rights of students are guaranteed, as provided for in

Decree 128/2010, of 14 September, on the accreditation of the linguistic knowledge of the teaching staff of the universities of the university system of Catalonia. At the time of signing the contract, the selected candidate may choose between the accreditation of Catalan language or the deferral of this accreditation for a period of two years. Non-EU foreign citizens and those who cannot be included in the scope of international treaties established by the EU and ratified by the Spanish State must have a work and residence permit before formalising the corresponding contracts.

3. Applications

3.1. Applications must be addressed to the Rector of the Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona (building A, Rector's Office, 08193, Bellaterra, Cerdanyola del Vallès), and must also be submitted using the electronic form enabled for this purpose that will be available on the university's e-Office ([Selection Form](#)) or through any of the procedures established in Article 16.4 of Law 39/2015, of 1 October, on the Common Administrative Procedure of Public Administrations, within twenty calendar days from the day following the publication of this call in the Official Gazette of the Government of Catalonia.

Applicants who opt for more than one place must submit a separate application for each place.

Candidates must attach the following documents in PDF format to the same electronic form:

(Check all the documentation on the Serra Húnter Programme website <https://serrahunter.gencat.cat/en/psh-general/presentacio-candidatures/index.html>)

- a. Copy of your national identity document (DNI/NIE/PASSPORT).
- b. Doctoral degree certificate, or receipt of having applied for it.
- c. Complete curriculum vitae, according to the [format proposed](#) by the Serra Húnter Programme.
- d. A document specifying the 5 most valuable academic contributions of the applicant (articles, books, patents, etc.) according to the model that you can download [HERE](#).
- e. A brief description of the teaching career (maximum 1 page), according to the model that you can download [HERE](#).
- f. A succinct statement of your teaching and research interests in line with the scope of the contract offered for the next 5 years. The document must not exceed six pages, according to the model that you can download [HERE](#).
- g. Accreditation of academic internationalization, according to the model that you can download [HERE](#).

Academic internationalization must be accredited for a minimum period of one year (by purchasing academic stays from two months). Serves to prove the academic internationalization of all academic activity carried out in a foreign (non-Spanish) institution during doctoral training or postdoctoral stage, whether having completed the doctoral thesis at a foreign university, pre-doctoral stays, Doctoral studies, post-doctoral contracts and/or teaching contracts. To prove academic internationalization, the university must submit the completed academic internationalization document. And if necessary, it will be necessary to provide documentation that verifies the academic activity carried out.

h. Certificates proving the necessary language level indicated in base 2.2.c if applicable.

Given the composition of the Selection Committees and as established in the Serra Húnter Plan 2024-2027 agreement, the documentation must be submitted in English.

3.2. In accordance with the provisions of article 60 of the RPA, on criteria for awarding the position of assistant lecturer, candidates who have the accreditation of assistant lecturer must attach the following document for evaluation:

- Favourable report from the AQU (Agency for the Quality of the University System of Catalonia), or accreditation from the ANECA (National Agency for Quality Assessment and Accreditation) for the category of assistant lecturer.

Being in possession of a favourable report in AQU accreditation will be considered as a preferential merit.

3.3. Candidates who have submitted their application for university contracts in the first part of the selection process must indicate to the management of the Serra Húnter Programme on the registration form whether they consider that the documentation is that which has already been submitted or if they are presenting updated or new documents, in line with point 3.1. In the latter case, the candidate authorises the university to have access to the documentation filed with the Plan's Directors.

4. Admission of applicants

4.1. On the tenth working day, once the deadline for submitting applications has ended, the provisional list of admitted and excluded candidates will be made public, in which the reason for exclusions must be indicated and the date of publication of the final list will be indicated. This list will be published on the University's website ([PDI Calls](#)).

4.2. Applicants will have a period of 10 days, counted from the day following the publication of the provisional lists of admitted and excluded candidates, to submit possible claims addressed to the same places indicated in point 3.1 to correct any shortcomings detected in the application, or to attach any missing documentation required by the call.

In the event that the excluded persons do not satisfy the shortcomings that, in each case, have led to their exclusion within the indicated period, they will be considered to have withdrawn from the competition and therefore, their exclusion will be considered final.

4.3. In accordance with the provisions of Article 45 of Law 39/2015, of 1 October, on the Common Administrative Procedure of Public Administrations, with the presentation of the resolutions indicated on the university's website, appropriate notification to the interested parties will be considered to have been made, and the deadlines for the purposes of possible claims or appeals will begin.

4.4. The University Administration may amend at any time, ex officio or at the request of a party, material, factual and arithmetical errors that have occurred in the procedure.

4.5. The interested parties may lodge a contentious-administrative appeal before the courts of contentious-administrative jurisdiction against the resolution of the final list of admitted and excluded candidates, which exhausts the administrative route, within a period of two months from the day following the notification of this list, in accordance with the provisions of Article 8 of Law 29/1998, of 13 July, regulating the contentious-administrative jurisdiction, without prejudice to the possibility of optionally lodging an appeal for reversal prior to the contentious-administrative proceedings before the Rector, within a period of one month, counted from the day following receipt of this notification or, where appropriate, from the day following its publication, in accordance with the provisions of Articles 123 and 124 of Law 39/2015, of 1 October, on the Common Administrative Procedure of Public Administrations.

5. Selection committee

5.1 The composition of the committees is that which appears in the annex to these terms and conditions and it will be formed in accordance with the provisions contained in the collaboration agreement between the Department of Business and Knowledge and the Catalan public universities for the Jaume Serra Hunter Plan for teaching staff contracted in the period 2016-2020.

5.2. The committee's internal operating rules are in accordance with the provisions of Law 26/2010, of 3 August, on the Legal Regime and Procedure of the Public Administrations of Catalonia.

5.3. The cases of abstention and recusal established in articles 23 and 24 of Law 40/2015, of 1 October, on the Legal Regime of the Public Sector, are applicable to the members of the committees. In the event that the reasons for abstention are present, the interested parties must refrain from acting in the committee and must state the reason.

5.4. For the purposes of communications and other incidents, the committee is based in the Rector's Office of the Autonomous University of Barcelona.

6. Selection process

In accordance with the provisions of articles 136.2 and 141.2 of the Statutes of the Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona, the evaluations made by the Selection Committee are based, at least, on the adequacy of the teaching and research curriculum to the profile of the position; the teaching and research needs of the department and the area of knowledge and linguistic competence, as determined by current legislation.

6.1. On the publication of the final lists of admitted and excluded candidates, the members of the Selection Committee will receive all the documents submitted by the admitted candidates.

The Selection Committee will be constituted within a maximum period of three months from the publication of the call. If after this period it has not been possible to constitute the committee, a reasoned request may be made to the rector for an extension of one month.

The constitution of the Selection Committee will be online and requires the presence of all full members. Full members who do not attend this event will cease form part of the committee and will be replaced by the corresponding substitute members.

At the time of its constitution, the Selection Committee, under the direction of the chair, must decide upon and make public the specific evaluation criteria.

The date of constitution of the Selection Committee will be published on the University's website ([PDI calls](#)).

6.2 Evaluation of the test

In accordance with the provisions of Article 60 of the RPA, in the first phase of the competition the committee will draw up a list of items that make up each criterion for assessing the candidates' CVs, taking into account the profiles established in the call for applications.

The criteria to be assessed are the following:

- Accreditation of Assistant Lecturer (obtained according to the LOMLOU 2001-2007) in the branch of knowledge of the position announced (preferential merit until and including the 2026 call for places. Third transitional provision, LOSU): 15 points.
- Carrying out university research, transfer and/or teaching activities for a cumulative period of at least 9 months in universities or research centres other than the university where the doctoral thesis has been presented (preferential merit): 15 points.
- Other research, transfer and/or university teaching mobility activities. The first 9 months of stays will not be taken into account since they already count for section 3.2: 10 points.
- Research and transfer activities (no subsection may exceed 15 points): 25 points.
- Teaching activities (no subsection may exceed 15 points): 25 points.
- Training activities: 5 points.
- Other merits: 5 points.

The sum of the score for all the criteria must be 100.

6.3 Phases of the competition

First phase (eliminary):

6.3.1. Within a maximum period of 20 days from the date its constitution, the members of the Selection Committee will send the secretary an individual assessment of the merits of each candidate according to criteria for assessing the high-level academic activity undertaken

internationally, and of their professional career, especially considering the significance and impact of the scientific and technical publications and the competitive research projects achieved; the quality and recognition of the teaching carried out; knowledge transfer activities, intellectual property rights and registered patents; leadership capacity; the mobility and international visibility and other outstanding academic and professional milestones of the candidate. They will also indicate, in order, the candidates who should pass the first phase.

6.3.2. Based on the proposals of its members, the committee will agree on the number of people who pass this phase, taking into account the academic merits of the candidates. In the event that the committee considers that no candidacy has the appropriate merits, it will be proposed to the rector that the competition be cancelled and that the contract be left vacant.

6.3.3. Once this first phase has been completed, the corresponding resolution of candidates who have passed it will be published and the second phase of the selection process for access to the contract will be opened.

Second phase (eliminary):

6.3.4. Within ten days of the publication of the results of the first phase, the committee will publish the calendar for the second phase at least three weeks in advance. This call will determine the place, day and time to carry out the selection test for each of the selected candidates. Before the start of the selection test, the committee may require applicants to provide documentation certifying the merits mentioned in their curriculum vitae, which will preferably be delivered in electronic format.

6.3.5. Candidates who do not show up at the appointed time will have a second call after 15 minutes. In the event that they do not appear, they will be considered to not have presented their candidature and, therefore, they will be excluded from the selection process.

6.3.6. The selection test will be public. Candidates will for a maximum of one and a half hours make a brief personal presentation followed by a seminar on the topic they consider appropriate. The committee will then ask the candidates any questions it deems appropriate, both on the merits provided in their curriculum vitae and on the seminar given, or on any other aspect related to the contract offered and the planned activity that they will carry out.

The second test will be based on a total of 30 points. The members of the committee will evaluate the following aspects:

- The presentation of the CV and the content of the seminar given: 15 points.
- The methodology used in the presentation, time management, communication skills, and overall effectiveness: 10 points.
- The responses to questions posed by the members of the committee: 5 points.

Given the characteristics of the Serra Húnter Plan, this test must be taken in English except in cases where the language is part of the position profile.

6.3.7. Assistant lecturers will be contracted for a maximum period of six years. After the first three years, the lecturer will be evaluated in accordance with the Serra Húnter Plan Agreement for contracted teaching staff for the years 2024-2027.

7. Contract proposal

7.1. Once the selection test has been completed, the committee will draw up a prioritised proposal of the candidates who have passed and will formulate a proposal for the recruitment of the candidate in first place.

The duration of the contract will be six years.

This proposal will be made public on the website of the Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona ([PDI Calls](#)).

If there no candidate is considered suitable, the competition will be declared vacant.

7.2. Once the recruitment proposal for the competition has been published, the candidates in the selection process may have access to the competition file, if they expressly request it at the place where the committee is based in accordance with rule 5.3.

7.3. Candidates may lodge a complaint with the Rector against the committee's proposal, within a maximum period of ten days from the day following the day on which the committee publishes the result of the competition.

The Complaints Committee is responsible for assessing the claims lodged against the proposals of the selection committees. The resolution of complaints must follow the same procedure as determined in article 50 of the Academic Staff Regulations.

8. Resolution of the competition

The Selection Committee will submit the proposal referred to in the previous point to the Rector, who will issue the corresponding resolution to award the contract to the appropriate candidate, who will have to execute the corresponding contract in accordance with the provisions of point 9 in this document.

The Rector's resolution, which finalises the selection process, also exhausts the administrative route, and the interested parties may file a contentious-administrative appeal against this before the Contentious-Administrative Court of Barcelona within a maximum period of two months from the day following the publication of the resolution.

However, interested parties may also file an optional appeal for reconsideration with the Rector within one month from the day following the publication of said resolution. In that case, a contentious-administrative appeal may not be filed until the appeal for reversal has been expressly resolved, or rejected.

9. Execution of the contract

9.1 In order to execute the corresponding contract within a maximum period of 6 months from the date of publication of the resolution awarding the contracts, the person to whom the vacancy is awarded must submit the following documentation to the University Registry:

- a) Sworn statement justifying the requirement specified in section b) of point 2.1
- b) Official medical certificate accrediting the provisions of section a) of point 2.1
- c) Declaration of not being included in any of the cases of incompatibility provided for by current legislation or exercising, within the period of taking office, the option provided for in Article 10 of Law 53/1984, of 26 December, on incompatibilities of personnel in the service of the Public Administrations.
- d) Original documents of the specific requirements provided for in point 2.2.
- e) Justification of compliance with the requirement established in point 2.3:

e.1 The means of accrediting knowledge of Catalan language established in Article 5 of Decree 128/2010, of 14 September, are as follows:

e.1.1 The Catalan Government's Catalan Proficiency Level Reference Certificate (Level C) established by current regulations on the assessment and certification of knowledge of Catalan .

e.1.2 Any of the degrees, diplomas and certificates that are considered equivalent to the certificate of proficiency in Catalan of the Government of Catalonia, in accordance with current regulations.

e.1.3 The certificate of sufficiency of teaching language knowledge that will be issued by the university and that can be obtained by:

- Taking a specific course organized by the university and passing it; or
- Through an evaluation carried out by the university.

e.2 Candidates who have completed accreditation in compulsory education, with the presentation of any of the non-university regulated education qualifications that are considered equivalent to the level of proficiency in Catalan, in accordance with current regulations.

e.3 Candidates who have participated in and obtained a place in previous processes of selection and access of teaching staff to access a university in which a Catalan test of the same level or higher has been established, by presenting the certification that accredits it.

e.4 In the event that the level of Catalan cannot be accredited by the above means, commitment to justify compliance with this requirement established in rules 2.3 within two years after the signing of the contract with any of the accreditations provided for in point e1.

9.2. If applicants do not submit the necessary documentation within the period referred to in point 9.1, except in cases of force majeure, which will be duly verified by the convening body, or if they do not meet any of the necessary requirements for their contracting, the award will be revoked,

without prejudice to the liability they may have incurred in the event of falsehood. In these cases, the award of the contract in favour of the corresponding candidacy will be resolved again according to the ordered list of proposed candidates made by the Selection Committee.

9.3. The contracts will establish the working conditions in the terms provided for in this call and by the relevant legislation, as well as the following additional clauses, which must be complied with by the teaching staff contracted within the framework of the Serra Húnter Plan:

- The person contracted will be evaluated specifically according to their academic merits, under the terms established by the Serra Húnter Plan.
- The person contracted must keep an annual, updated summary, of a maximum of two pages, of the most relevant aspects of their curriculum vitae, which will authorize it to be published on the website of the Serra Húnter Plan.
- The person contracted must sign all their academic and scientific production as " Professor/professora Serra Húnter ", "Serra Húnter Fellow" or " Profesor/profesora Serra Húnter ", depending on the case.
- In the event that the person contracted loses their affiliation to the Plan for whatever reason, that person will not be able to sign as a "Professor/professora Serra Húnter", "Serra Húnter Fellow" or "Profesor/profesora Serra Húnter". The above clauses will therefore not be applicable.

9.4. The execution of the contract will preferably be deferred to the beginning of each academic semester. In any case, the contract must be executed within a period of no more than six months from the date of the resolution of the tender.

9.5. Internationalisation

In accordance with the current agreement with the Serra Hunter Program, academic internationalization is a requirement to be able to be attached to the Serra Hunter Plan and become a Serra Hunter professor or professor. That is why it will be requested that the candidate indicate it during the first part of the selective process.

People who cannot prove internationalization will not be excluded from the contest at the university, but it must be considered that internationalization will be valued by the selection committee. If a person who cannot prove a minimum of one year of academic internationalization wins the contest, it cannot be assigned to the Serra Hunter Plan.

10. Return of the documentation

Within a period of three months from the resolution for awarding the contracts, the interested parties may have the original documentation submitted returned. Once this period has elapsed, it will be understood that they renounce its return.

11. Protection of personal data

In accordance with the provisions of Article 13 of the European General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), you are informed that the personal data included in this form will be processed by the Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona, the data controller, for the purpose of managing your participation in the selection process.

The UAB will process your personal data in compliance with the public interest mission entrusted to it by Organic Law 2/2023, of 22 March, on the University System, and Law 1/2003, of 19 February, on Universities in Catalonia.

The UAB will not transfer your personal data to third parties or other recipients, except in the cases provided for by law or when it is mandatory, and your data will not be subject to international transfer.

The UAB will publish the resolutions and administrative acts referring to the selection process in accordance with the requirements of current legislation on administrative procedure and staff selection by the public administration.

The UAB will also make public information including your personal data under the terms required by Law 19/2014, of 29 December, on transparency, access to public information and good governance.

Your data will be kept for the time necessary for the purposes of the processing.

The processing of your data does not involve automated decisions, nor the creation of profiles for predictive purposes of personal preferences, behaviours or attitudes.

In accordance with current legislation on the protection of personal data, you may revoke your consent at any time and exercise your rights of access, rectification, deletion, opposition and limitation of processing by means of a request addressed to the data controller (upac@uab.cat), or to the General Secretariat of the UAB, Bellaterra University Campus, Rector's Building, Plaça Acadèmica, 08193, Bellaterra (Cerdanyola del Vallès) (sec.general@uab.cat).

You can also submit complaints to the Catalan Data Protection Authority (<http://apdcat.gencat.cat/ca/inici/>) and make any queries you consider necessary to the UAB Data Protection Officer (proteccio.dades@uab.cat).
