CLUSTER 2: EU CONTEXT

- * Democracy faces **most serious crisis** in decades. Decline in democratic standards a constant trend of last decade. Various European surveys show **declining levels of trust** to political institutions (Freedom in the World Report 2018)
- * Automation impact: **14% of jobs** in 32 OECD countries are highly **automatable**, equivalent to 66 million jobs (OECD 2018. Also Mckinsey 2017).
- * Need to reduce rising inequalities (European Pillar of Social Rights).
- * Cultural Heritage creates **12 million jobs**; promotes European values and helps develop a European Identity.
- * Largest number of arrivals of **refugees and migrants** since end of Second World War. Respond to challenges, promote integration, enhance governance






HORIZON EUROPE STRATEGIC PLAN: SSH CONTRIBUTION

"Interdisciplinarity and inclusion of Social Sciences and Humanities (SSH) aspects is a prerequisite for addressing a number of societal challenges, which are cross-cutting by nature and should be actively implemented throughout the whole research programme".

"The challenges we are facing today are of such a nature that few can be addressed through one scientific discipline alone. **Social Sciences and Humanities** (SSH) are key to understanding the relationships between human behaviour and major global challenges, but also to the effectiveness of the solutions we propose to address them. For instance, SSH can contribute to our understanding of how best to engage with citizens in tackling pressing societal concerns such as climate change and the related need for adaptation, as well as how to exploit new technologies in a way that is focused on citizens' needs and concerns.

In addressing and understanding citizens' expectations and preoccupations, SSH contributes substantially to strengthening society's ability to embrace and drive change, whether economic, social, or technological or cultural, and thus to achieving many targeted impacts across the programme. Furthermore, SSH helps to better understand the socio-economic outcomes of research policy itself and to enhance its societal impact in the future. Finally, SSH is a key element in fostering the necessary behavioural change in a number of important areas, such as mobility i.e. achieving a socially acceptable, environmentally responsible and fair transition towards new modes of transport."




