Definition

Academic recognition refers to the inclusion in a student's academic record of credits earned through participation in activities not included in the curriculum of the degree programme being studied. In the case of FUAB Formació-Turisme i Direcció Hotelera, the maximum number of credits that will be recognised in the student's academic record is 12 credits.

Clarification regarding the Language Service. The documents provide the UAB Language Service's level table as a reference. This does not exclude commonly accepted language certificates, which are listed in the various UAB regulations.

Recognition of languages: English, French, German and Chinese.

For training in one of the foreign languages taught at the center*, a maximum of 6 credits per language will be recognized, based on the levels of achievement of the center:

o English:

- Students of the degrees who have studied English I, II and III in our center will be able to recognize 6 credits by presenting a C2 level accreditation.
- Students of the degrees who have not taken English as a language in our center may recognize 6 credits by presenting an accreditation of level C1 or higher.

o French:

- Students of the degrees who have taken French I, II and III in our center may recognize 6 credits from a level of B2 or higher.
- Students of the degrees who have not taken French as a language in our center may recognize 6 credits by presenting an accreditation level B1 or higher.

o German:

- Students of the degrees who have taken German I, II and III at our center may recognize 6 credits from a level of B1 or higher.
- Students of the degrees who have not taken German as a language in our center may recognize 6 credits by presenting an accreditation level B1 or higher.

o Chinese:

- Students of the degrees who have taken Chinese I, II and III at our center may recognize 6 credits from a level of B1 or higher.
- Students who have not studied Chinese as a language in our center may recognize 3 credits by presenting an A1 or A2 level accreditation and 6 credits by presenting a B1 level accreditation or higher.

Recognition of other languages (excluding English, French, German and Chinese):

For language courses in a foreign language other than those taught at the centre, you may be awarded 3 credits for each level achieved, in accordance with the UAB Language Service's level scale, up to a maximum of 12 credits. If you submit a B2 certificate or higher, 12 credits will be awarded.

- **Spanish:** If you completed your secondary education in a country where Spanish is not the official language, you may be awarded 3 credits per level if you can demonstrate that you have achieved at least level 4 of the UAB Language Service.
- **Catalan:** If you completed your secondary education in an autonomous community or country where Catalan is not the official language, you can be awarded 3 credits per level if you can demonstrate that you have reached level 1 or higher at the Language Service.
- **Catalan:** If you completed your secondary education in an autonomous community or country where Catalan is an official language and you demonstrate level 9 of the Servei de Llengües (C2), you can be awarded 3 credits.
- **Occitan (Aranese):** If you completed your secondary education in a region, autonomous community or country where Occitan is not an official language, you may be awarded credits if you can demonstrate that you have achieved level 1 or higher of the Servei de Llengües.
- **Official languages of other autonomous communities, other than Spanish:** If you can demonstrate level 9 of the Servei de Llengües (C2), you can be awarded 3 credits.

Recognition of UAB Barcelona Summer School courses:

- The possibility of recognizing the courses offered at the UAB Summer School establish a maximum of 12 credits, therefore two courses taken and passed, with the exception of language courses, where the rules set out in the previous points will be followed.
- 12 credits will be recognized as long as no credits have been recognized for other activities.
- As indicated at the time of enrollment in the UAB Summer School, courses that belong to the curriculum of the Degree in Tourism or the Degree in Hotel Management, offered by the UAB Summer School, will not be recognized.

Recognition Student representation of students:

The maximum number of credits that may be recognized will be 3 credits, counting a total dedication of 75 hours to student representation activities..

To recognize these 3 credits the following requirements must be met:

- Having been a delegate during the 4 years of undergraduate studies.
- Exercise of the functions of delegate (meetings with the other students and delegates; transmission of the opinions of the group of students to the Direction of the center;...).
- Attendance to the activities of representation set by the center:
 - Attendance at 100% of the meetings of delegates convened by the Head of Studies.
 - Attendance to 100% of the accreditation activities of the center.
 - Attendance at 75% of the cloister meetings called by the center's management, as long as you are a student

Attendance to the delegate meetings may be exempted when at the same time an evaluation activity is scheduled, an activity representing the center (Open Day; Workshop; Saló Estudiu); or a duly justified illness
