

Accordingly with the SERRA HÚNTER PROGRAMME SELECTION PROCESS - GUIDELINES FOR THE SELECTION COMMITTEES:

The second phase is conducted face-to-face and takes place at the hiring university. It includes a qualifying selection interview and the proposal of the candidate who should be hired, in order of priority. The face-to-face test assesses the suitability of the candidate for the contract on offer. This will be public and, for a maximum of an hour and a half, candidates will be required to introduce themselves briefly and give a seminar on an appropriate subject. Before this phase takes place, the committee can agree to publish indications for the candidates on how to perform the oral presentation. After the presentation, the committee may ask any questions it deems necessary regarding the candidate's CV, the seminar they have given or any other aspects related to the post offered and the activity to be developed.

The committee agree to provide the following indications:

First. Present at 9am in Seminar E1- Business Department, Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona (Building B, Room: B1-138, see [link](#) for maps and other indications). The room is equipped with a PC using a windows operating system, Microsoft Office programs, access to internet and a projector. Second. About the structure of each candidate oral presentation, we suggest the following timing:

- i) Brief introduction. Remember that the committee members already have read your documentation and the purpose of the selection process is to assess your suitability for the contract on offer (Recommended: Maximum 10 minutes).
- ii) Seminar. Present a representative piece of your research. It could be an already published paper or current work in progress (Recommended: Maximum 30 minutes).
- iii) Committee questions regarding the candidate's CV, the seminar they have given or any other aspects related to the post offered and the activity to be developed.
