ASSESSMENT CRITERIA

The members of the Selection Committee agreed to evaluate the CVs and supporting documents of the candidates according to the following criteria:

Research merits: up to 60 points including publications, stages in research centres, international contacts, participation in research projects, acquisition of research funds, patents, potential of leading a research group, and participation in conferences/seminars.

Teaching merits: up to 30 points including teaching experience at undergraduate and postgraduate level, supervision of theses and student's projects, teaching in specialist and diverse fields and positive evaluations.

Other merits: up to 10 points including awards, university management responsibilities, participation in committees, science dissemination and outreach.

Adequacy to areas of expertise and needed profile by the Department. The candidate will be asked to teach in one or more of the following subjects: Zoology and, in particular, Entomology.

Candidates will move to Stage two if they receive a minimum score average of 80 points or more.
