More than 370 people registered for the conference, aimed primarily at people who incorporated the doctorate this year. This session has highlighted the importance of ethics in research and how it is reflected in the code of good practice. It has also been explained the importance of the document of doctoral commitment that is signed at the beginning of the process of elaboration of the doctoral thesis. At the same time, emphasis has been placed on the value of transversal skills training and excellence in research, while at the same time being basic in order to be valued in very different professional settings. The lectures were broadcast by streaming and were followed via the internet by users from all over the world.

UAB wants to consolidate this model of transversal skills training activities.
