

## **ACTION IN CASE OF AN EMERGENCY**

#### **Fire**

### **Accident**

### **Evacuation**



Ring the alarm bell, if there is one close.



If necessary, protect yourself from the cause of the accident.



When you hear a continuous alarm sound, leave whatever you are doing, stop all machines and stay calm.



Call the Security Service and tell the nearest porter's office



Call the Medical Service and the Security Service.



Follow the emergency exit Signs and obey any instructions given by evacuation personnel.



Use the extinguishers only if you know how to operate them.



Stay close to the injured. Do not move them. Keep them warm and reassure them.



Do not use the lifts – you may become trapped.



Do not use the fire hoses.
