

ON THE TOP OF BARCELONA: *Tibidabo*

If you are interested in getting one of the best panoramic views of Barcelona don't miss this activity!

"*On the Top of Barcelona: Tibidabo*" is a walk along the footpaths of Collserola Natural Park up to the top of Tibidabo, where the amusement park of the same name is located. It is also the peak of the Collserola mountain range and the highest point in Barcelona at 516.5m.

There you can find the Tibidabo viewpoint from where you can enjoy one of the best views of the whole city.

This is a group activity and it offers you a healthy and entertaining way to get to know the outskirts of the campus and the city.

The walk up to Tibidabo

1. Depart the campus by train (FGC) to Baixador de Vallvidrera station.
The walk begins after classes finish.
To get to the starting point for the walk we have to catch the train from the Autònoma station on the UAB campus (towards Barcelona) to Baixador de Vallvidrera station.



2. Let's start waking!
We're heading for the Collserola Information Point, first along a footpath and then up some stone steps.
At the Information Point there is a bar where you can buy your lunch. You could also buy it on the campus before you catch the train.
This is a good time to stop for lunch before the real walk begins.



3. Walking up to Tibidabo.

While we're walking we have to follow the signs for 'Tibidabo'.

There are plenty of signs and the path is broad and easy to follow the whole way up.



4. Arrival at Tibidabo and end of the walk

Once we arrive at the top there are two viewpoints.

One is outside the amusement park and the other is inside just in front of the "Big Wheel"). You can go to either since the first level of the park is free entry.

You can also visit the church and even go up the tower. The views are amazing. Just at the foot of the church is the Tibidabo for a drink or for something to eat to get your strength back!



5. Journey home

There is a bus stop right in front of the church.

*The No. 111 bus will take you to *Peu del funicular*. There you can either catch the train (FGC) towards Sabadell to return to the UAB or towards Barcelona.*
