

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION ON THE CHARACTERSITSICS OF THE DOCUMENTATION THAT NEED TO SUBMIT

## 1. What is a certified photocopy of a document?

This refers to a photocopy that the public administration has contrasted with the original documentation and for (by means of an official stamp) it attests that it is in complete accordance with that original.

The official stamp can be provided by the institution that issued the document or also by these <u>other institutions</u>.

A photocopy of a certified photocopy, or a printed version of a scanned certified photocopy, will not be considered valid documents.

Note: a "certified copy" may also be termed a "true copy".

## 2. What is the legalisation of a document?

In Spain, this is always required when the documents are issued by a country other than Spain. It refers the procedure that, depending on the country of issue, must be followed to confirm the authenticity of the document, its signature and the motives and capacity with which the authority signing the original document has acted.
