**DISTANCE LANGUAGE LEARNING**  
**(ENGLISH, FRENCH, GERMAN, SPANISH, ITALIAN,**  
**PORTUGUESE, RUSSIAN)**

Self-learning using the Dexway online platform for the following languages and levels:

- English, German, French and Spanish: levels A1 to C1 of the CEFR.
- Italian, Brazilian Portuguese and Russian: levels A1 and A2 of the CEFR.

Individual work on the platform allows students to do exercises in grammar, vocabulary, listening, reading and writing in line with the European framework of reference for languages.

The Dexway method offers a communicative approach. Students have access to all the levels available in the language they want to study and progress in a structured and planned manner.

Learners have access to the course whenever they want and from any device with no need for prior installations; or they can use the mobile app.

Learning is complemented with conversation classes and language exchanges offered by the Language Service of the UAB.

**Aimed at**

People who want to learn or perfect their language skills using online resources.

**Hours**

The hours of connection expected for each level are as follows:

- Levels A1 and A2: 80-100 hours per level
- Levels B1, B2 and C1: 120-150 hours per level

**Access to the course**

12 months from the date of enrolment.

### **Other information**

- If you enrol on an English e-learning course you are entitled to a discount on *T-10 English Conversation*, a card that gives you 10 English conversation sessions of 1 hour each.
- Students can address any technical questions they have via the online platform.
- This online course is based on self-learning and does not include language tuition.
- There is no final assessment. Students may request a certificate to show the number of online hours they have spent during the course and, if they wish, may enrol for the Language Service exams (except Portuguese and Russian).
  - Enrolled students receive a short guide to get started on the platform.
