

BLENDING INTENSIVE PROGRAMME COURSES



Dear ERASMUS+ partners,

In spring 2026, Turība University will offer three different BIP courses for your students. All courses will take place from May 18-22. We will accept 2-4 students from each partner institution to ensure diversity and intercultural teamwork. You are welcome to select and send your students for a wonderful experience in Riga!

Costs – Turība University will cover costs for study programme, study visits, teaching materials and lecture costs.

Travel and accommodation costs must be financed from the partner University ERASMUS+ mobility grant.

Accommodation is available in our student hostel (a place in a four-bedded room) for **48 EUR** for the entire course period. A limited number of two-bedded rooms will also be available – the price for the entire course period is **83 EUR**. Please note that availability is **not guaranteed** and depends on the number of free rooms at the time of reservation. Please note that the price is very reasonable, but the accommodation is simple, as is typical for a student hostel. BIP COURSE “SECURITY AND CRISIS MANAGEMENT” (BIP No. 2025-1-LV01-KA131-HED-000307250-2)

During this BIP course students will have the opportunity to learn about security risk and crisis management, develop skills and gain knowledge about planning and implementing security management in various organizations.

Participants – Bachelor’s and Master’s students in Security and Business, as well as other students interested in security and crisis management.

Credits: 3 ECTS

BIP COURSE “LEADERSHIP AND CRITICAL THINKING” (BIP No. 2025-1-LV01-KA131-HED-000307250-3)

During this BIP course, students will explore the essence of leadership and develop critical thinking skills essential for decision-making in complex environments. The course combines theoretical perspectives with practical exercises that strengthen students’ ability to analyse problems, evaluate alternatives, and lead teams effectively in dynamic and multicultural contexts.

Participants – Bachelor’s and Master’s students in Business, Management, Communication, or related fields, as well as other students interested in leadership development and analytical thinking.

Credits: 3 ECTS

BIP COURSE “CHALLENGES OF ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE IN LAW” (BIP No. 2025-1-LV01-KA131-HED-000307250-4)

Artificial intelligence presents new challenges in the field of law, particularly regarding liability, data protection, and copyright, as traditional legal principles often fail to address situations created by advanced technologies. The European Union’s 2024 Artificial Intelligence Act introduces a risk-based approach to AI regulation, setting stricter requirements for high-risk systems, including those used in judicial and security sectors.

Participants – Bachelor’s and Master’s students of Law, Legal Studies, European Studies, as well as students from related fields (e.g. Business, Public Administration) who are interested in understanding how AI affects legal systems, regulation, and human rights.

Credits: 3 ECTS

Only students from partner Universities (having ERAMUS+ cooperation agreement with Turība University) are eligible to participate.

Each course will include three introductory online lectures in April and May 2026, where students will meet other participants and take part in topic-related sessions.
