What are the JCP Scholarships?

- ASÎTÎ: Fostering the role of young internally displaced persons and refugees in the long-running conflicts of Syria and the KRI and of the youth of the host communities of Jordan and Catalonia in the construction of peace and security, consolidation of democracy and human rights in the Middle East
- Generating knowledge in the field of peacebuilding, consolidation of democracies, and conflict transformation

Why are they important?



- Strengthen the capacities of women as key agents in peace building
- Facilitate higher university education for young women from Syria/Iraq/Kurdistan
- Promote interconnected knowledge and effective networking
- Create a direct impact on the academic **community of the UAB**

Who are they addressed to ?



UMB CAMPUS

- Three (3) positions for women who are in Syria, Iraq or Kurdistan, and who wish to continue their university career in Catalonia.
- Experience in **peacebuilding, gender and climate justice** (academic, professional, activist or other).
- Human rights' advocacy and/or community engagement
- **Graduate degree or PhD** that **contributes to peace building**, consolidation of democracies and conflict transformation.
- Participate in the UAB university community as well as in FAS projects
- **Research links** and networking between UAB and the home university.
- Contribute to **peacebuilding in Syria**, Iraq and Kurdistan

- Meet the academic requirements of the selected studies at the UAB (visit the respective master's program website)
- All UAB official master's programs (excluding Erasmus Mundus and interuniversity programs)

When must you apply?

- The period for submitting <u>applications is now open!</u>
- It will close on 3rd May 2022, at 00:00 hours
- Interviews with shortlisted candidates in between 4-17th May
- Resolution of the awardees no later than 31 May.
- All applicants will be notified via e-mail of their status after each stage of the selection process.





How to apply?



UAB CAMPUS

- **1. Online application form**. It must include a brief training/research proposal specifying academic aspirations within the selected programme.
- **2. Motivation letter** specifying experience in activism, community leadership and or advocacy.
- 3. Brief CV
- 4. Copy of the passport;
- 5. Supporting documentation of previous studies

UPB CAMPUS



- The scholarship is intended to support only the student herself.
- Full tuition fees for the 2022-2023 academic year at UAB
- Exemption from any other academic fees associated with the programme followed at the UAB
- Monthly allowance for accommodation expenses (preferably housing in Vila Universitària de la UAB) and living expenses during the academic stay at UAB. This allowance consists of 965€ per month during 10 months;
- The scholarship includes a **one-time extra payment of 965€** for other study-related expenses
- Travel expenses
- VISA arrangements
