1. **Subjects with only a change in name and/or content**

(Introduction to Tourism Law, Computer and Study Skills, Introduction to the Tourism Business, and Quantitative Techniques Applied to Tourism)

→ You will be able to attend the new subjects and be assessed normally according to the new curriculum.

2. **Introduction to the Tourism Economy**

This subject has been modified more significantly. You will have two options:

- **Option A:** Attend the classes of the new subject 107762 – Tourism Economics, complete continuous assessment and the corresponding tasks. The teaching staff will provide the relevant instructions before the start of the course. Please note that the academic and exam calendar corresponds to subject 107762 – Tourism Economics (first year of the new curriculum).
- **Option B:** Opt for single assessment, using the materials corresponding to the 2024/25 or 2025/26 academic year (Introduction to the Tourism Economy), which will be available in a specific space on the virtual campus. Please remember to check the dates of the final exams in the official exam calendar.

3. **Analysis of Tourism Sector**

This subject is no longer offered. Teaching staff will create a space on the virtual campus with materials from the 2024/25 or 2025/26 academic year, tutorials will be offered if necessary, and a single assessment exam will take place on the official exam date. The 2026–27 academic year will be the last year this subject is offered.
