1. **Subjects with only a change in name and/or content**

2. **Economics of Tourism**

This subject has been modified more significantly. You will have two options:

- **Option A:** Attend the classes of the new subject 107762 – Tourism Economics, complete continuous assessment and the corresponding tasks. The teaching staff will provide the relevant instructions before the start of the course. Please note that the academic and exam calendar corresponds to subject 107762 – Tourism Economics (first year of the new curriculum).
- **Option B:** Opt for single assessment, using the materials corresponding to the 2025/26 academic year (Economics of Tourism), which will be available in a specific space on the virtual campus. Please remember to check the dates of the final exams in the official exam calendar.
