

## **Serra-Hunter Lecturership position: UAB-LE-232-006**

### **Second Phase**

#### **Instructions for the organization of the Interview and seminar presentation**

This second part of the selection process will be run in-presence format at UAB premises (refer to the room and time in the official document released by the UAB).

Each candidate has 90 minutes (maximum) to present his merits by following this scheme:

- Maximum 45 minutes for the presentation and discussion of his curriculum vitae. The candidate will have around 25 minutes for presentation of his merits and 20 minutes for the discussion with the members of the panel. The suggested items to focus on are:
  - 1) Short biography of the own academic career;
  - 2) Major achievements in terms of research outputs and the correspondent contribution in the field(s) of research;
  - 3) Ongoing and future research projects and the expected impact in the research field; prospective international research collaborations; ongoing and future participation(s) in national and international research projects; prospective research collaborations with the member of the Department of Applied Economics at UAB;
  - 4) Teaching: current teaching experience and expected involvement in the teaching load of the Department of Applied Economics at UAB; development of the own teaching philosophy.
  - 5) Target(s) for the development of the future academic career.
- Presentation of an unpublished research output as a seminar: maximum 45 minutes for presentation (around 30 minutes) and discussion with the members of the panel (around 15 minutes).

This presentation has to be organized as a regular research seminar and it will follow the rules of a standard research seminar in academia.

Selected candidates are kindly requested to inform about the title of the presentation and provide a draft of the paper or other research output to the members of the commission at least ten days before the scheduled meeting.

The merits that will be assessed in this phase are:

- Discussion of the CV and relevant merits; future research plans and projects; teaching; and fitting with the ongoing research groups (15 points);
- Presentation of the research paper (25 points);
- Discussion about the questions raised by the committee concerning the topics discussed in the previous points (10 points);

A final score will be assigned to each shortlisted candidate. Then, the selected candidate will be the one with the highest final score.
