Second Phase

Instructions for the interview and seminar presentation

The second part of the selection process will be conducted in person at UAB premises (refer to the room and time in the official document released by the UAB on the web).

Each candidate has 60 minutes (maximum) to present his merits by following this scheme:

- Presentation of the curriculum vitae (maximum 30 minutes). The suggested items to focus on are:
 - 1) Short biography of the academic career;
 - 2) Major achievements in terms of research outputs and the correspondent contribution in the research field;
 - 3) Ongoing and future research projects and the expected impact in the research field; prospective international research collaborations; ongoing and future participation in national and international research projects; prospective research collaborations with the members of the Area of Nutrition and Bromatology (Department of Animal and Food Science at UAB);
 - 4) Teaching: current teaching experience and skills as well as the candidate's expected fit and contribution to the teaching assignment and needs of the Nutrition and Bromatology Area. Teaching philosophy and capabilities of the candidate.
 - 5) Targets for the development of a future academic career.

- Presentation of a relevant research output (published or unpublished), focusing on scientific quality, methodology, originality, robustness, impact, funding, transfer to society, and future work, as well as the specific role played by the candidate. Where possible, special attention should be given to how this work aligns with the teaching needs and research lines relevant to the position profile. Candidates are encouraged to highlight not only their contributions to the project but also, where applicable, how their expertise and research could support the research agenda and teaching objectives of the receiving group (maximum 30 minutes).

This presentation must be organized as a regular research seminar. The presentation will be followed by discussion with the members of the evaluation committee.

Selected candidates are kindly requested to inform about the title of the presentation and provide a draft of the paper or other research output to the members of the commission at least seven days before the scheduled meeting.
