Lucia obtained her doctorate at the Localization Research Centre (LRC) in the Department of Computer Science at the University of Limerick. Her doctoral research was conducted within the framework of the Center for the New Generation of Localization (CNGL).

For over 15 years, Lucía has been actively involved in the field of localization standards and has co-directed the technical committee of the OASIS XLIFF standard since 2020. Her main research areas are localization standards, teaching localization, accessibility of localized products, and metadata in translation memories.
