

## RESEARCH LINES

### DEPARTMENT OF MEDICINE

1. **Cardiology and cardiovascular risk:** Study of different aspects related to the heart and arteries, also includes the study of the main vascular risk factors.
2. **Dermatology:** Includes all research work aimed at inflammatory, genetic or tumor diseases of the skin, as well as the dermatological aspects of systemic diseases.
3. **Digestive and hepato-biliary:** Any study related to the digestive, liver and bile duct systems, from a medical perspective.
4. **Endocrinology:** Includes all research studies related to the endocrine system.
5. **Multidisciplinary clinical research:** Research on clinical aspects of medicine where different specialties participate in coordination.
6. **Infectious diseases:** Study of infectious processes that can affect humans.
7. **Physical medicine and rehabilitation:** Includes aspects of rehabilitation in its various aspects.
8. **Nephrology:** Research on aspects related to the nephro-urological system from the medical perspective.
9. **Neurology:** Research on different areas of the nervous system, whether vascular or degenerative.
10. **Oncology and hematological diseases:** It includes all those research works that are oriented towards the analysis of different areas of cancer and blood diseases.
11. **Respiratory pathology:** It includes the study and research on areas of the respiratory system (asthma, interstitial lung disease, alveolitis...).
12. **Imaging techniques:** Research study aimed at the profitability of the use of new imaging techniques.
13. **Immunology, allergy and systemic diseases:** It includes research studies on systemic autoimmune diseases or other autoimmune disorders, as well as research aimed at the study of allergic processes from different aspects of knowledge.
14. **Minority diseases:** Line aimed at the study of those diseases that, due to their low frequency, can be included in this section.
15. **Family and community medicine:** Study of different aspects of medicine related to patient care in the field of primary care.
