

Resolution of February 23, 2026, publishing the updated waiting list for incoming staff mobility under Erasmus+ KA171 2024 from third countries not associated to the Programme, as part of the 2nd Resolution (November 28, 2025) ordered by professional seniority.

Whereas the Erasmus+ KA171 2024 Call for Applications for incoming staff mobility from third countries not associated to the Programme establishes in section 9 that, in case of a tie in the total score, the next tie-breaking criterion to be applied is professional seniority at the home institution;

Whereas in the previous resolution, tied candidates were provisionally placed at position 1 of the waiting list pending submission of an official certificate indicating the start date of their contractual relationship with their home university;

Whereas the required certificates have been received within the 10-calendar-day period granted from the publication date of the resolution;

I HEREBY RESOLVE:

First. To publish the updated waiting list of candidates, ordered according to professional seniority (start date of contractual relationship with the home institution):

Second. Reserve candidates on the waiting list will be contacted in case of withdrawals or in the event of a redistribution of funds resulting from a lack of applications or unused funds in other categories in the same region.
