The International Summer School 2026 at TUM School of Management, in collaboration with the TUM SEED Center, is a two-week intensive program in Munich focused on sustainable energy and entrepreneurship.

Hosted by one of Europe's leading technical universities, the program combines academic rigor with applied venture development.

Designed primarily for highly motivated master's students in sustainability, energy, engineering, business, and related fields, the program brings together a carefully selected international cohort. Participants explore the global energy transition, apply venture development methods.

Through interactive lectures, expert workshops, and collaborative project work, the Summer School bridges cutting-edge research with entrepreneurial practice. The program culminates in a final team pitch, equipping participants with practical startup tools, a refined venture idea, and an expanded international network.
