

Workshop "Connecting drivers for sustainable development in the Mediterranean Region"

22nd September 2015, 12:00 - 14:00

Background

At the recent UN Conference for Sustainable Development (Rio+20), 193 Heads of State and Governments reaffirmed the importance of promoting sustainable patterns of consumption and production (SCP) as an overarching objective of, and essential requirement for sustainable development. The UN Post-2015 Development Agenda – due to be adopted by the General Assembly in late September as a concrete outcome of the Rio+20 conference –, further highlights the central role of SCP in achieving the Sustainable Development Goals at the heart of the new global framework for sustainable development.

In the Mediterranean region, shifting to SCP and circular economy to decouple development from environmental degradation and resource depletion has become an urgent need due to the pressure that the economic development of the 21 Mediterranean countries is exerting on the local environment. Yet the shift to SCP and circular economy can only be achieved with the active participation and collaboration of all relevant actors, including: governments and policy makers, businesses and entrepreneurs and, civil society organisations and individual citizens.

Introduction

On **Tuesday, September 22nd** the Sant Pau Art Nouveau Site will host an **informative session** on the need of connecting drivers for SCP and circular economy in the Mediterranean region. The main topics of the workshop will focus on (i) the importance of multi-stakeholders collaboration in achieving UN Sustainable Development Goals including SCP and other goals driving to circular economies; (ii) the Mediterranean region as case study on the key role of countries cooperation to enable the conditions for a paradigm shift towards SCP as strategic approach for socio-economic development in the region; and (iii) the presentation of **SwitchMed Connect** as the event connecting the main agents performing as catalysers of the development of SCP solutions in the Mediterranean countries.
