ANNUAL PHD STUDENT PROGRESS MONITORING

The annual monitoring of PhD students is structured into two key phases: a public oral presentation of the thesis progress and the submission of a working paper (or any other written material relevant to the work being presented).

Calendar and communication: The program coordination will inform doctoral students annually about the scheduled calendar for the monitoring sessions, as well as the criteria and the process for appointing the defense committees.

Procedure: The PhD student must submit the written material to the committee members at least 10 days before the oral defence.

Evaluation: The Doctoral Studies Committee, based on the defence committee's report, will recommend to the Postgraduate Studies Committee whether the student should continue in the programme. If the grade is "not favourable", the student must re-enrol for the same monitoring process and undergo a re-assessment within a maximum period of six months.
