

Doctorate Program in Bioinformatics

Follow-up session, course 2019-2020

There will be four sessions, for four groups of 10 students:

- Session 1: June 12th 2020, morning, at UdG premises (time and place to be announced)
- Session 2: June 12th 2020, afternoon, at UdG premises (time and place to be announced)
- Session 3: June 22th 2020, morning, at UdL premises (time and place to be announced)
- Session 4: June 22th 2020, afternoon, at UdL premises (time and place to be announced)

Follow-up Commission:

Will be integrated by the coordinators of the program at the six participant universities.

Format of the sessions:

Each student will make a presentation of 15', followed by 5 to 10' of questions and discussion.

The presentation should include:

- Introduction
- Objectives
- Research done during the course 2019-20
- Activities followed during the course (conferences, seminars, stays abroad, ...)
- Degree of accomplishment of the research plan
- Plan for the course 2020-21

One week before the session, the students must deliver to the coordinator:

- Update of the Research Plan, highlighting the work already performed and introducing any changes to the plan already made or foreseen.
- Document of Activities (summary of activities and the corresponding certificates of attendance).
- Brief report from the thesis director(s) indicating the progress during the course 2019-20 and his/her degree of satisfaction with it.
- Brief report from the tutor (if different from the director) indicating whether the thesis is progressing as planned or problems or conflicts of any nature have arisen.
