By **May 20th 2024**, a digital file should be sent to the coordinator of the area (melindaann.dooly@uab.cat). The file (pdf format) should include the following:

Report from the doctoral student (7-10 pages) should follow this structure as much as possible:

- Basic information of the thesis (title, director, author)
- Project Summary
- Research progress: tasks performed / research advances
- Difficulties (if any) and how they have been / will be resolved
- Work plan for the following period
- Bibliography
- Summary of supervision activities (tutorials, action points, etc.)
- Participation in training activities (brief description)
- Annexes: record of training activities (certificates, etc.)

The file should be saved as follows: surname of the doctoral candidate_panel#_2024 (ex. Garrido_panel1_2024)

Additional details for the annual report for the first year:

Include: problem statement or research questions; context and methods; scientific and social relevance, ethics protocol

Additional details for the second and subsequent years' annual report:

Include: methodology overview, provisional results; ethical issues and rationale for significant changes in the study (if applicable)

Request for extension (if applicable)

If a student plans to request an extension, they can state this in their report, although they must follow the procedure and deadline established for the request for an extension.

Please bear in mind that these panels are in-person. Students are required to stay for their panel. It is highly recommended that students attend more than one day of activities and panels.

General process:

1) A written report, report from the director, and document of activities are delivered by the indicated dates. 2) An oral report is given by the PhD student to the follow-up evaluation panel appointed for this purpose and made up of 3 researchers from the field of language and literature teaching. The event will consist of a 7-minute oral presentation by each student, followed by time for Q & A, discussion and reflection with the other participants of the panel (doctoral students and panel research members). **The principal supervisor will send their report separately to melindaann.dooly@uab.cat before the date of the panel (pdf format, entitled: report_director_cognom of the doctoral candidate).**

Aims:

The purpose of the evaluation panel is not to emit any qualification of the thesis. The evaluation panel members will provide immediate recommendations and observations related to the doctoral research to the candidate and based on the written and oral reports, will provide a report suggesting that the doctoral candidate is either progressing adequately or, to the contrary should **re-submit for evaluation in September**.
